

The North American proposal and the Micronesian proposal are similar; both decrease the cumulative (2013-2050) direct GWP-weighted consumption of HFCs to 21-22 GtCO<sub>2</sub>-eq from 146-231 GtCO<sub>2</sub>-eq, for a total of ~125 to 209 GtCO<sub>2</sub>-eq in mitigation. This is equivalent to a reduction from projected annual emissions of 5.5 to 8.8 GtCO<sub>2</sub>-eq/yr in 2050 to less than ~0.3 GtCO<sub>2</sub>-eq/yr. (The reference scenarios for calculating the effects of the proposals are from Velders et al. (PNAS, 2009) without any updates.)
